Featured Callers & Teachers

Glen Morningstar - Glen and his wife Judi have been leaders in the Country Dance & Song Society for more than 30 years, especially in maintaining the Henry Ford legacy of elegant "old-time" American Dancing in Greenfield Village, Michigan. Glen will emphasize historical dance as well as exciting contras and squares. Both Glen and Judi are accomplished musicians, offering workshops of dance band and shaped note singing.

Stacey Dewitt - Stacy returns by popular demand from last year. She is a certified clogging instructor from Indiana who has been dancing for more than half her life, including performances from Branson to Vienna. Stacey was inducted into the NCHC hall of fame in 2006.

Shane Gruber - Shane started his clogging career in 1989 and became a certified clogging instructor in 1996. He is an active choreographer for various organizations and leads the Shane Group Cloggers. Shane works for Michigan Network Services and teaches dance workshops in the US, Canada, Germany and the National Clogging Convention.

They are known for their wide variety of music styles, from hard driving fiddle tunes and mellifluous twin fiddling to sensitive waltzes. Chris was the Arkansas state old-time fiddle champion when he was 16.
